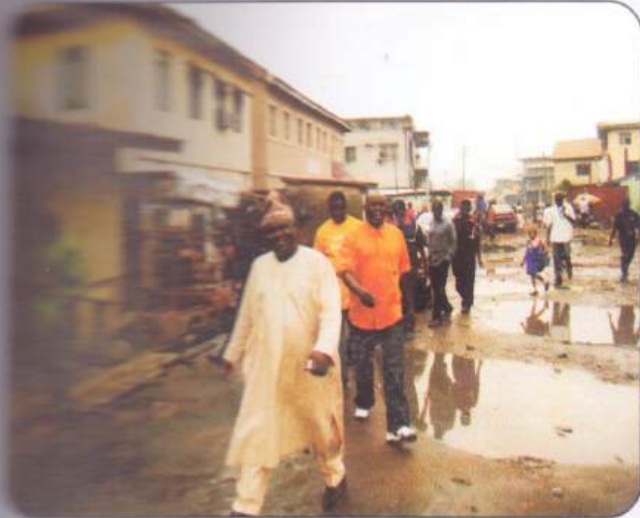

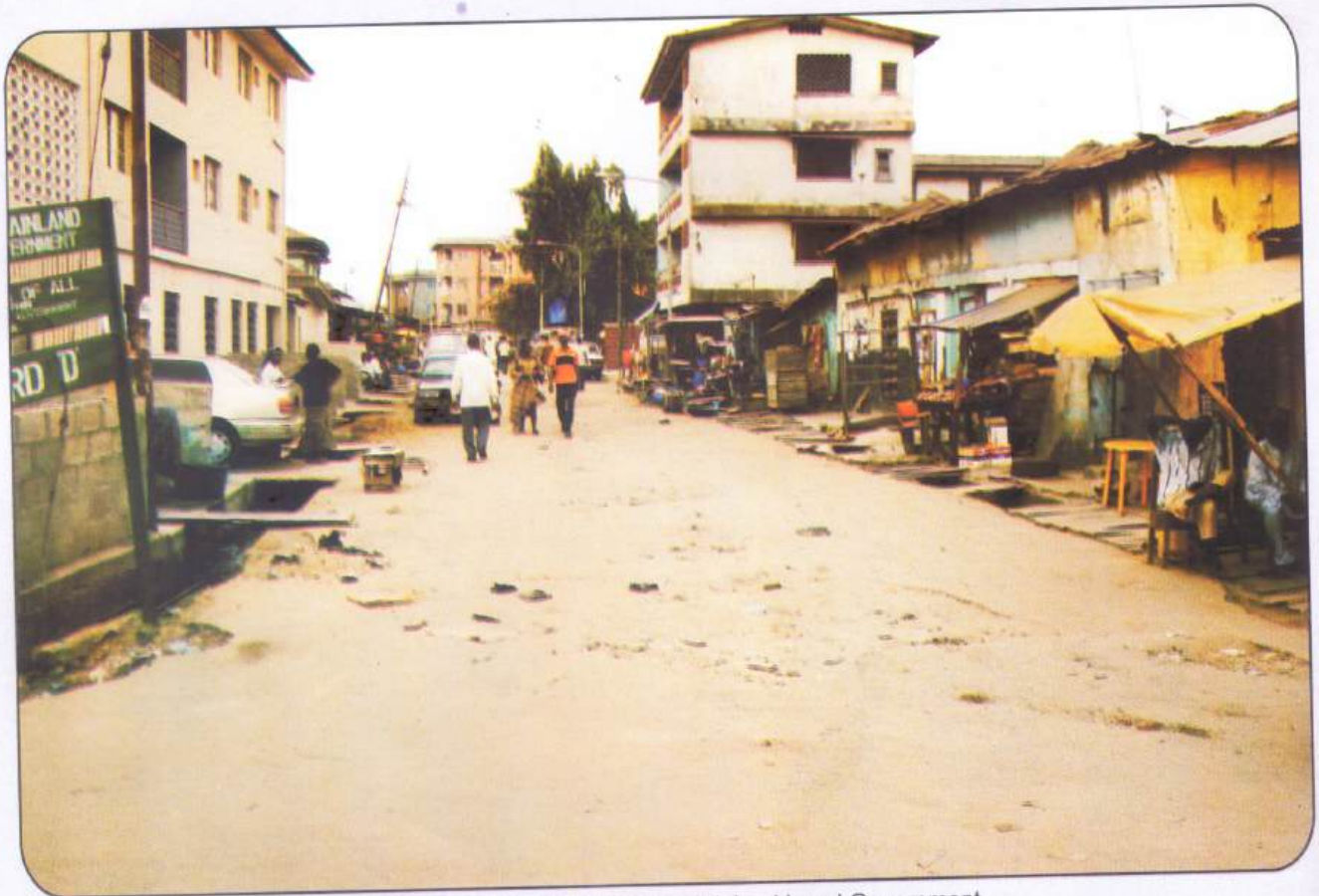

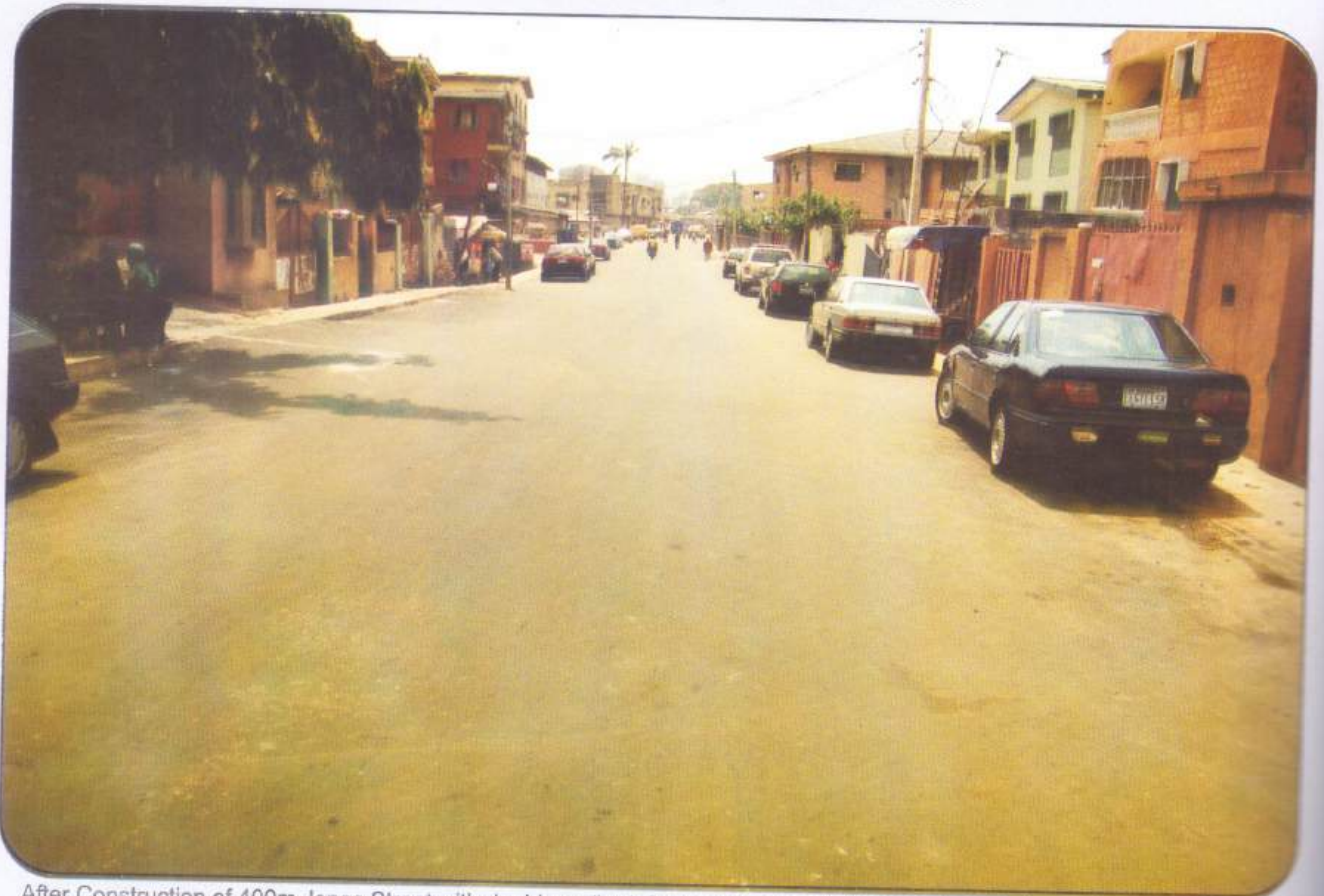

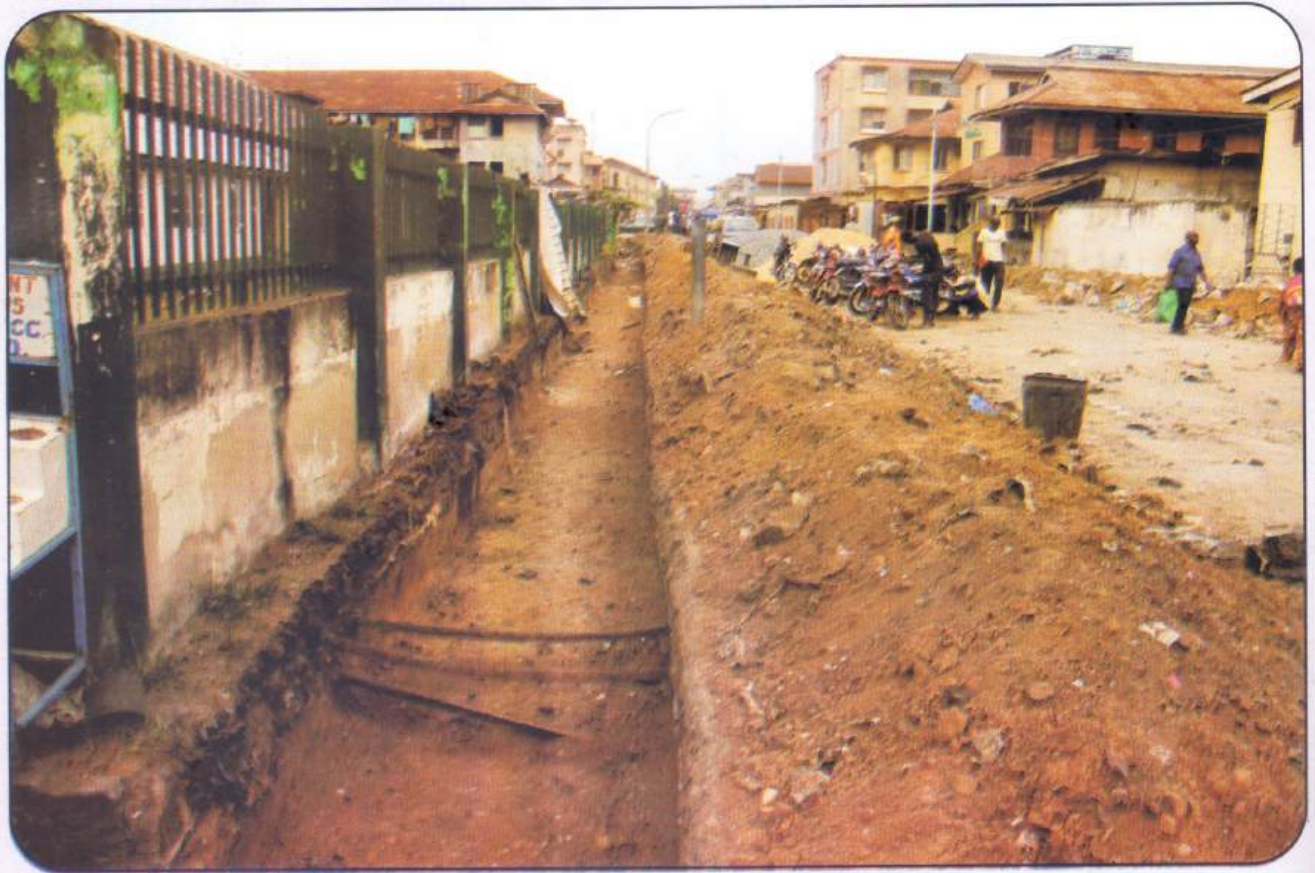

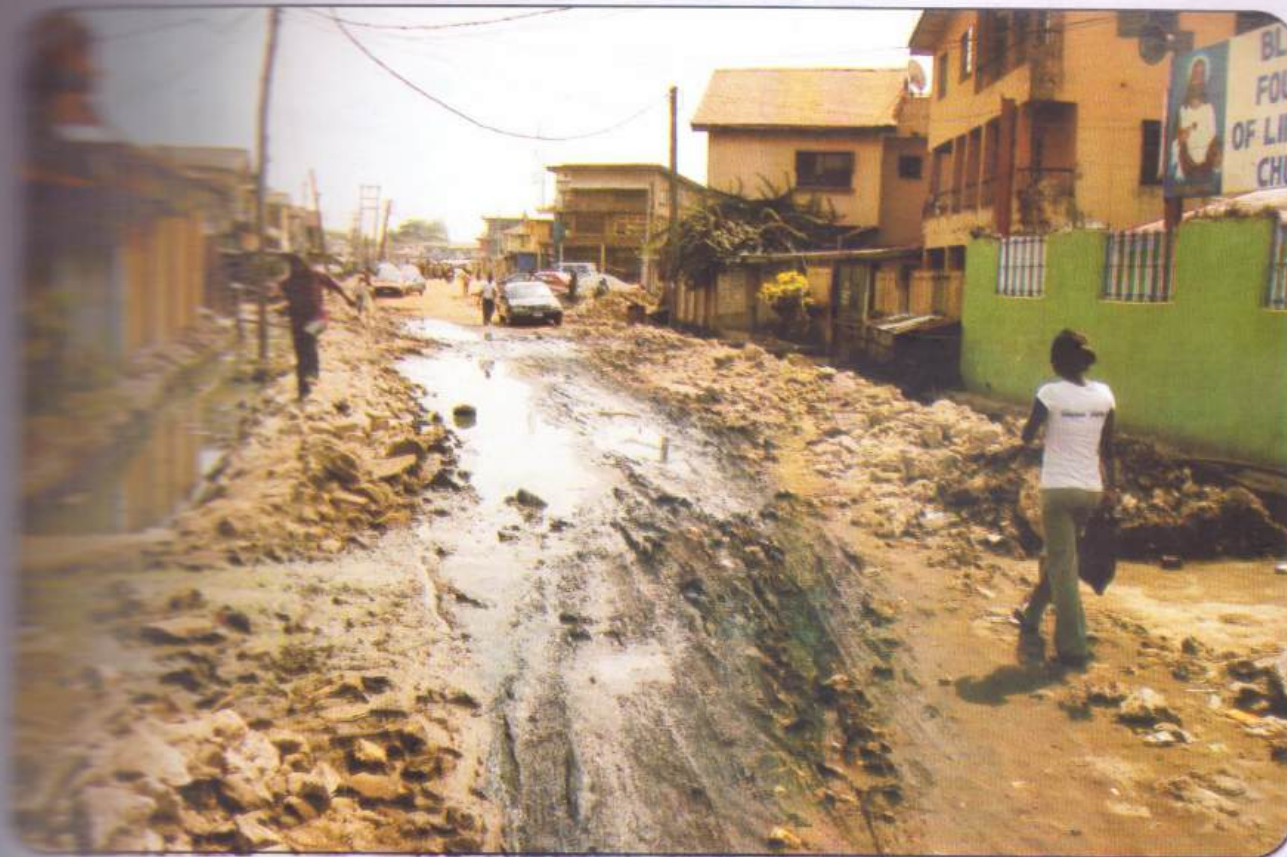

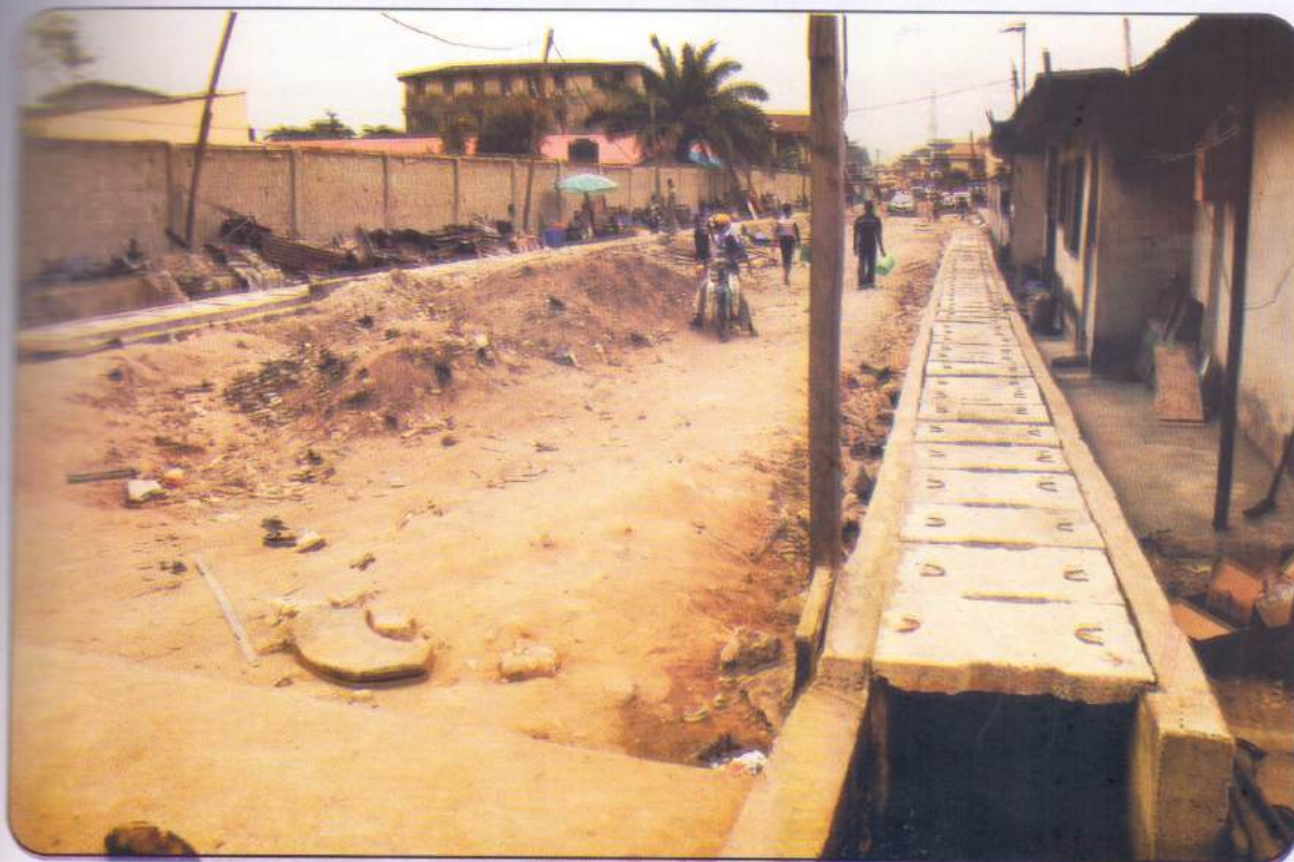


After Construction of 800m drainage system with double wall reinforced concrete and a concrete covered slab

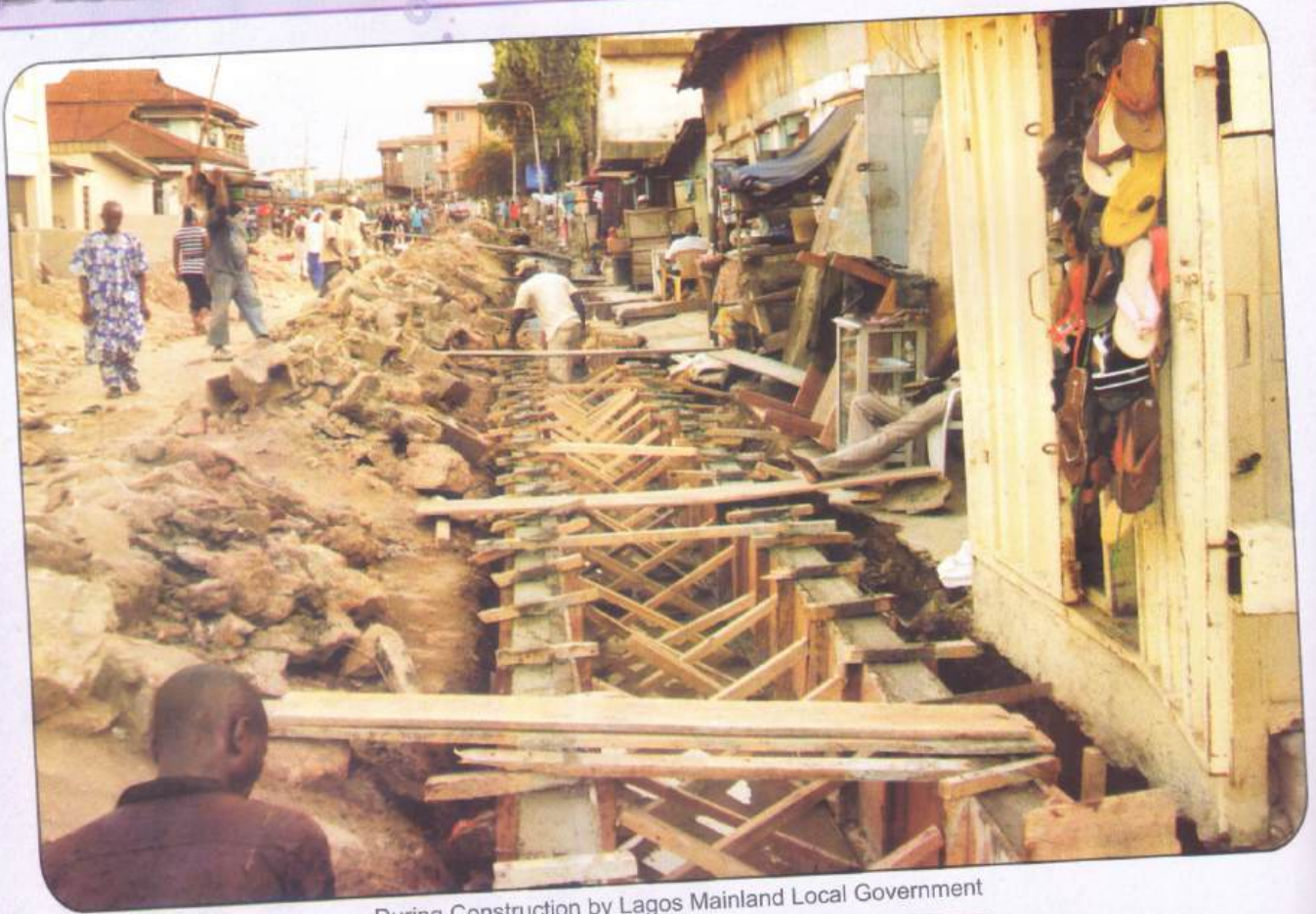

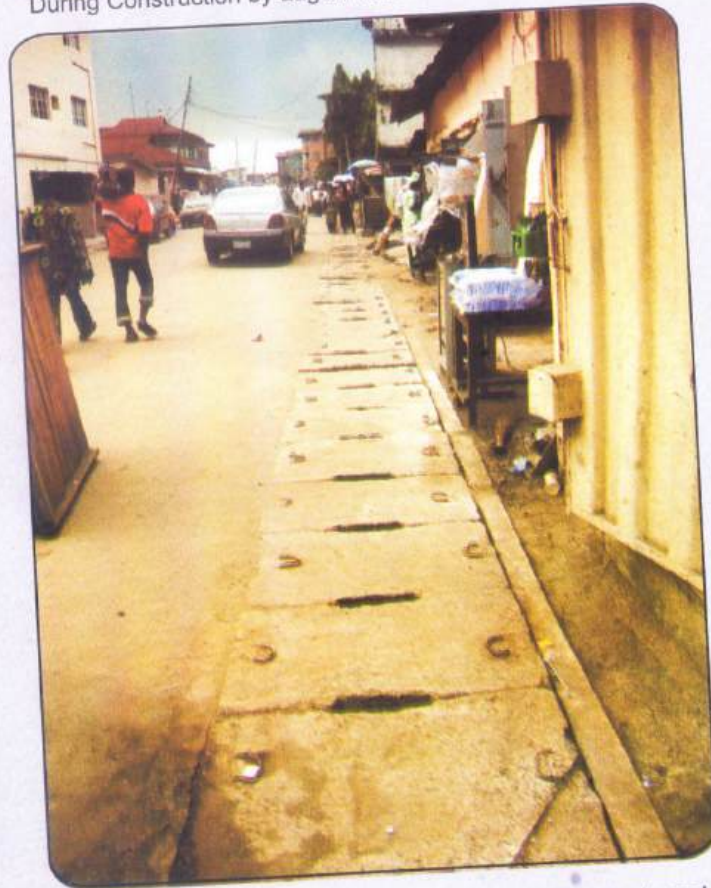


After Construction of 1800m drainage system with double wall reinforced concrete and a concrete covered slab

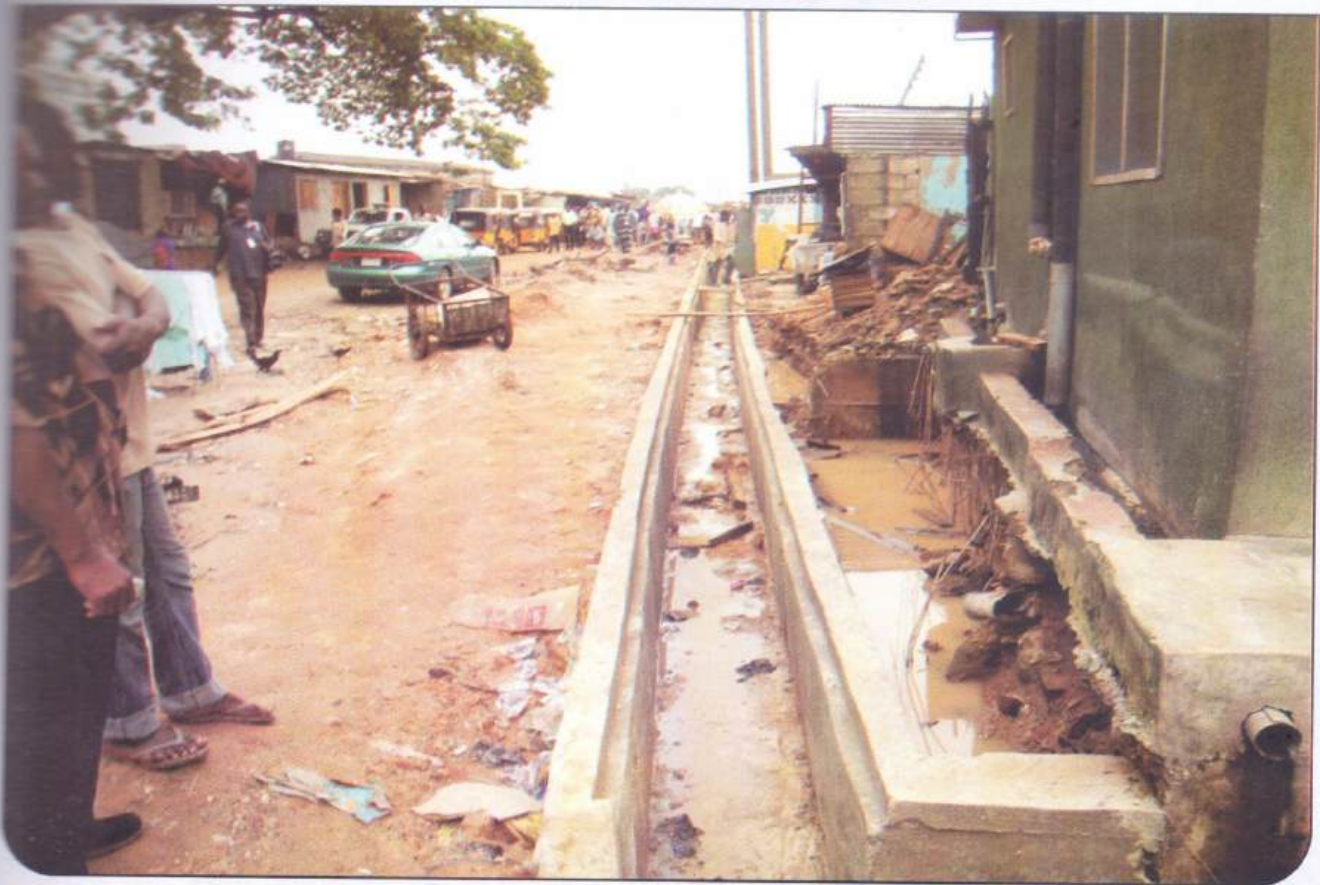

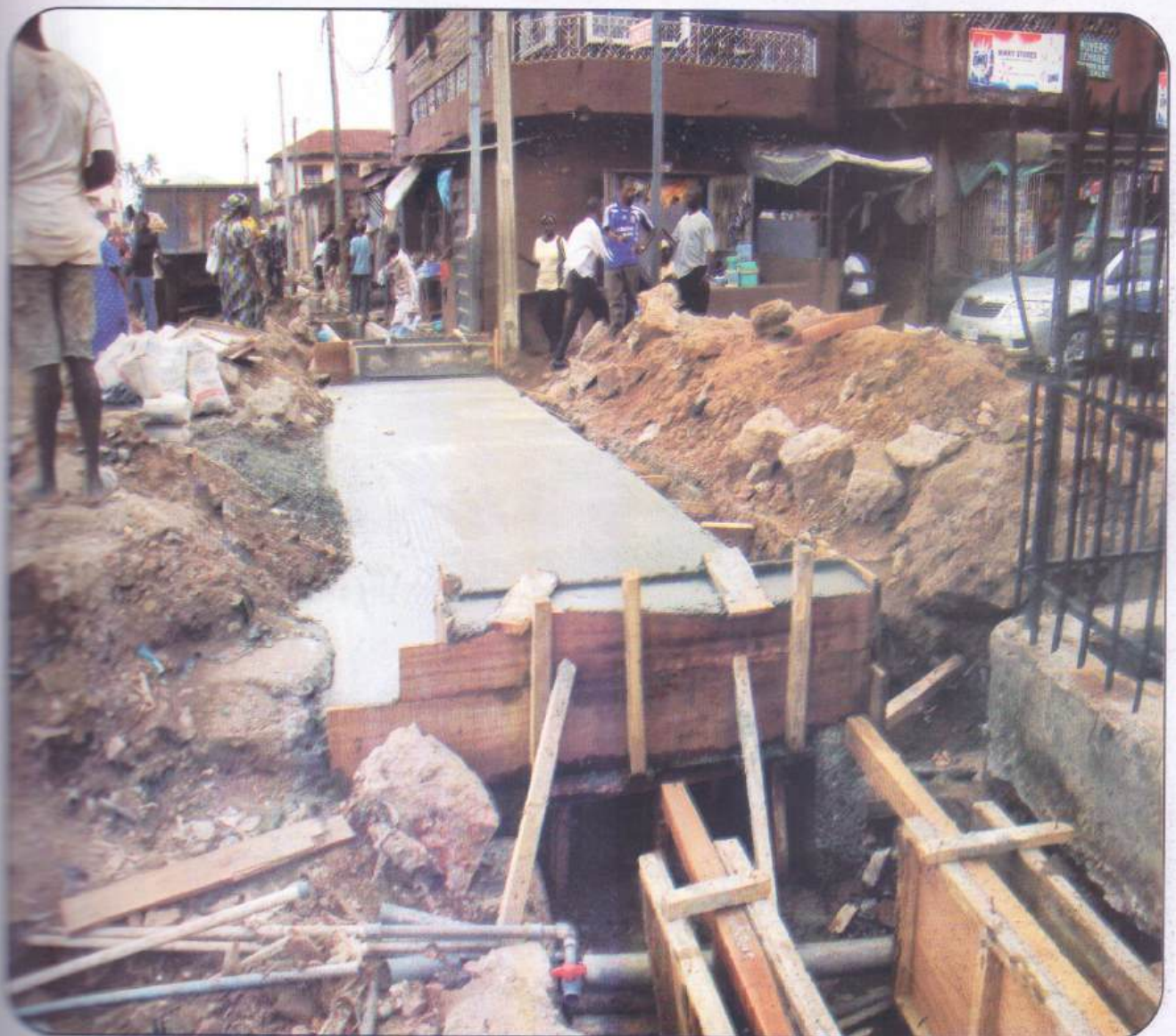

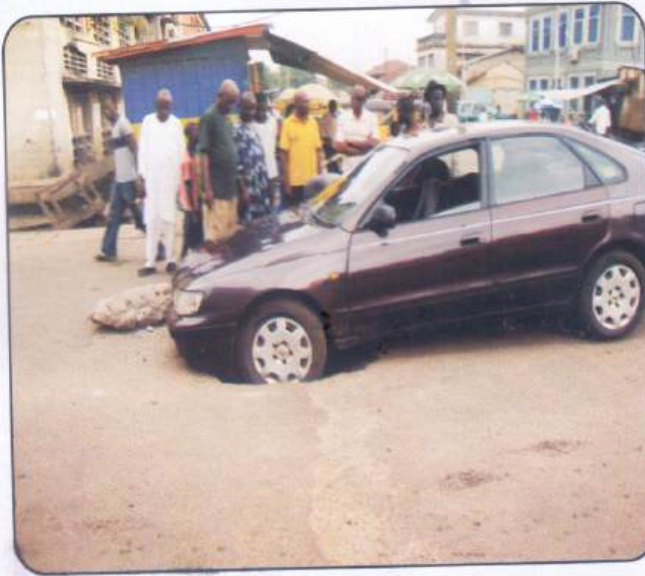

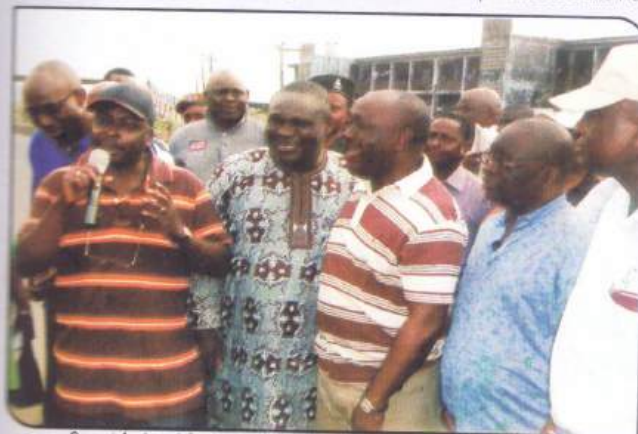

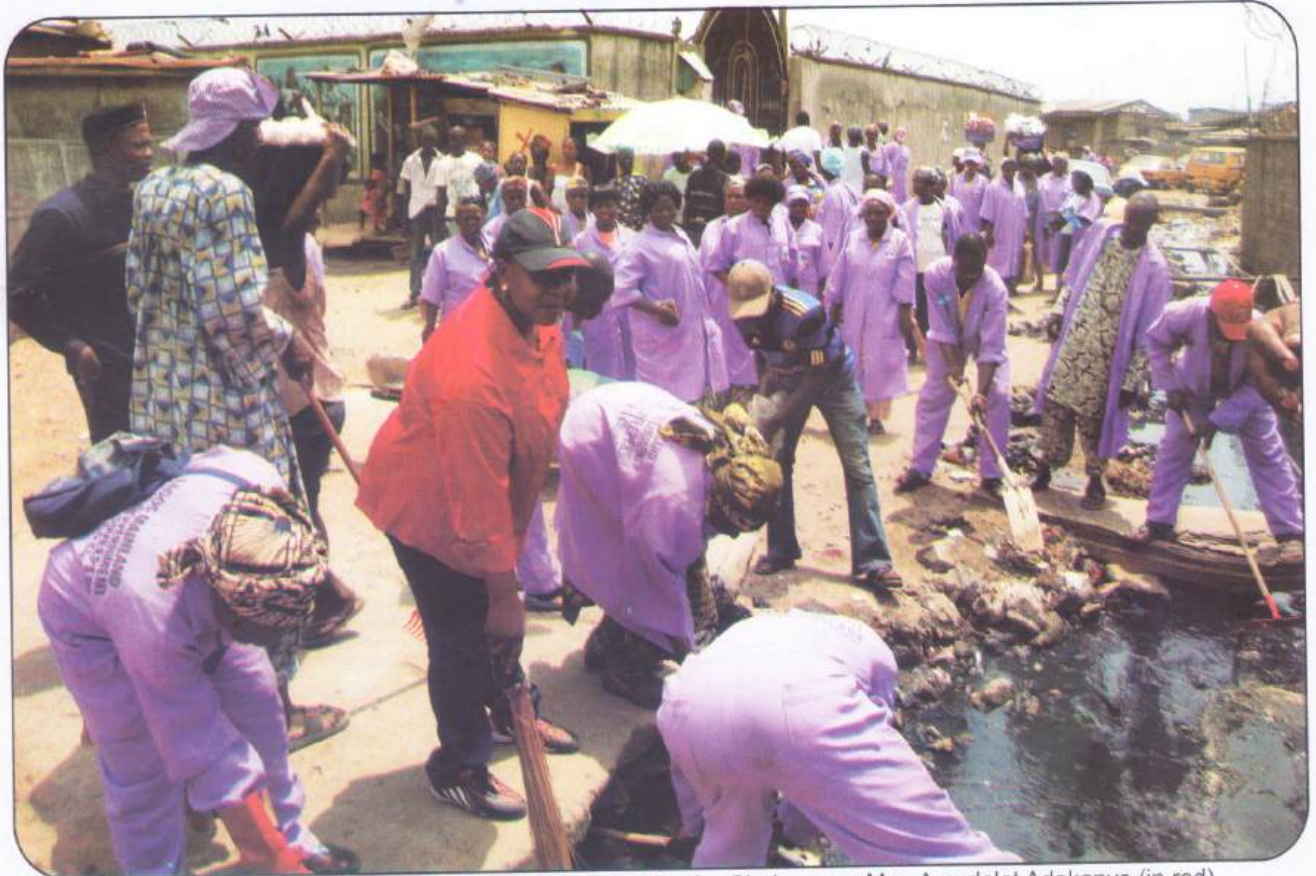

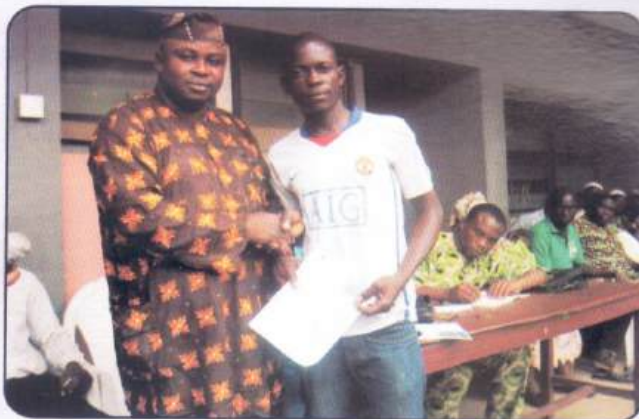

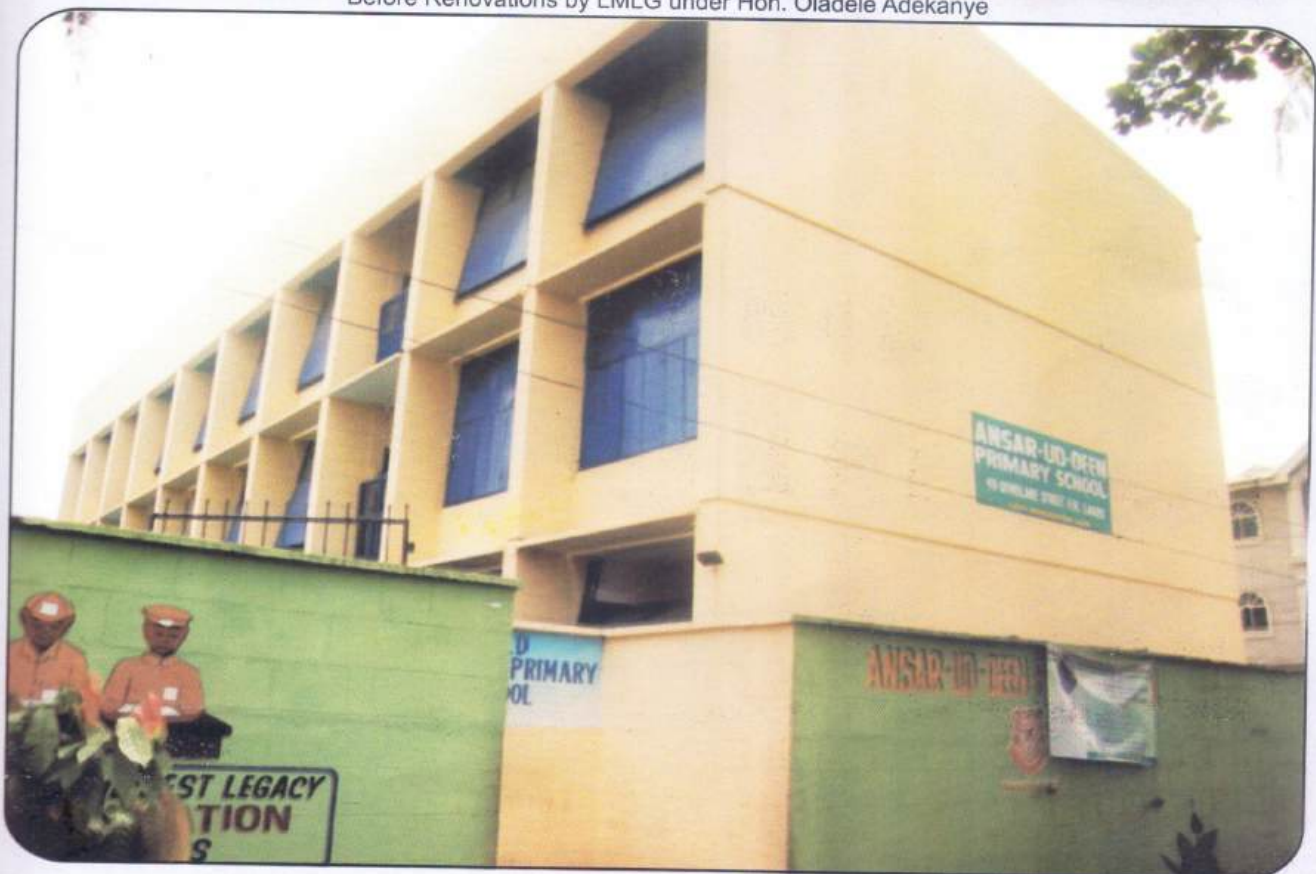

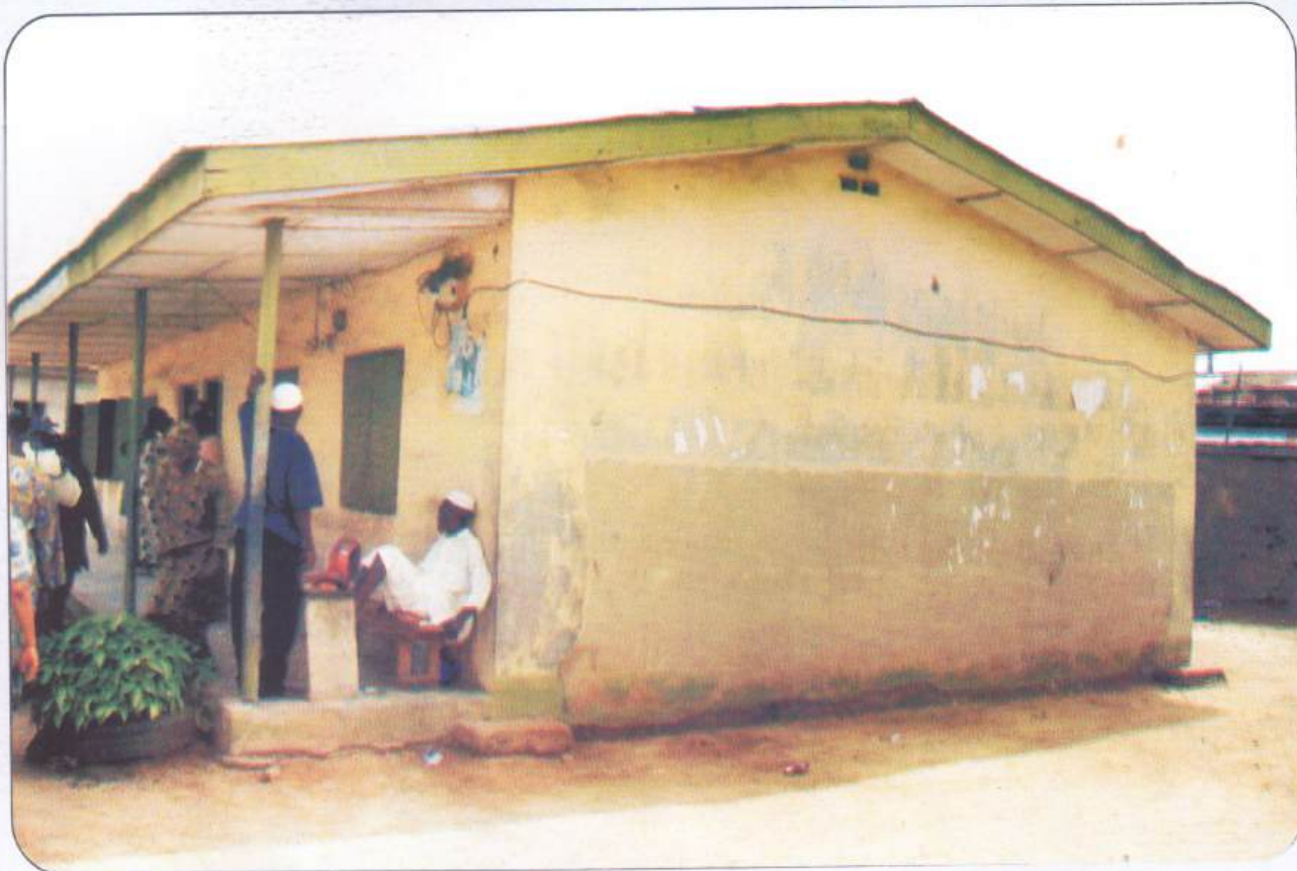

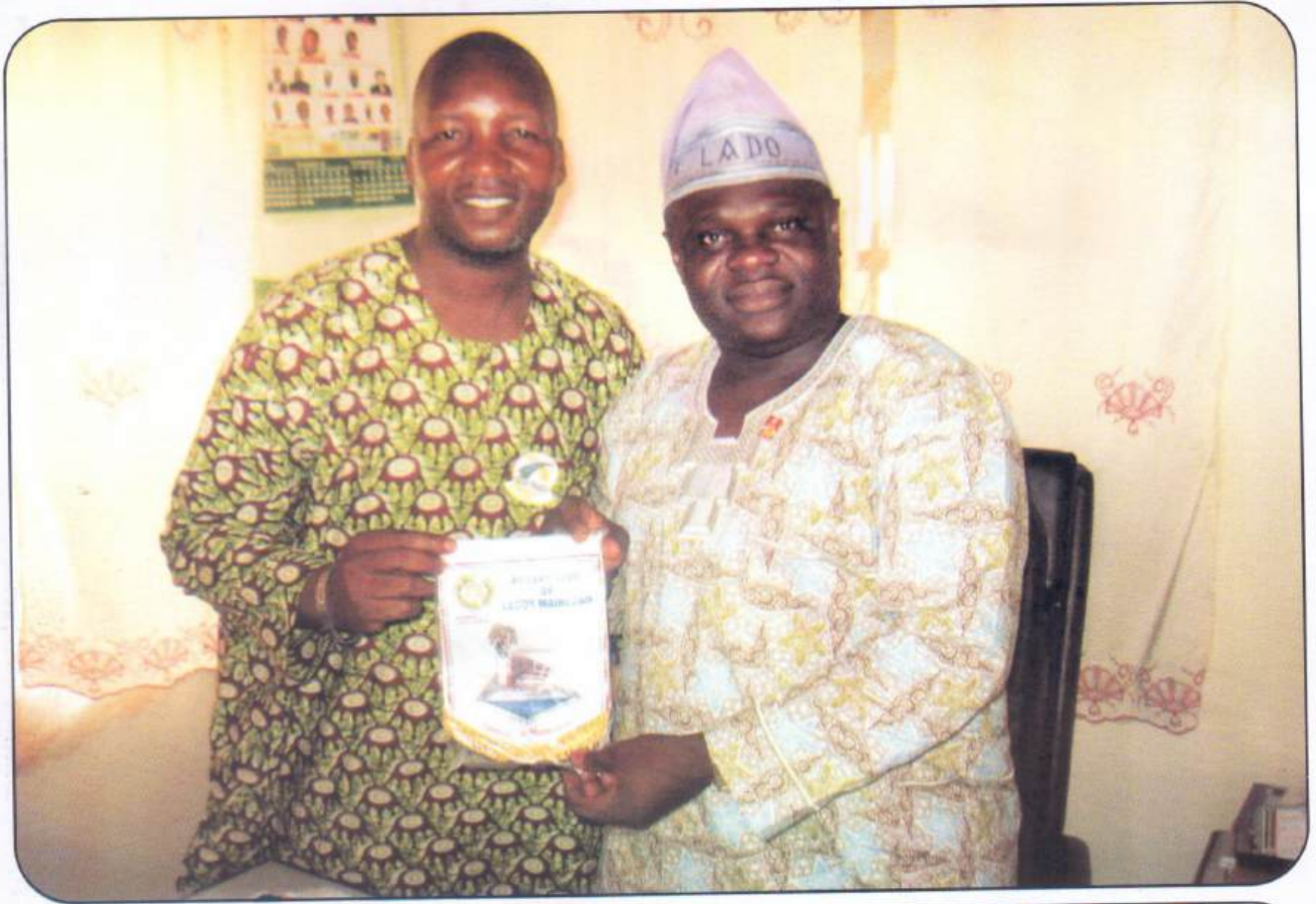

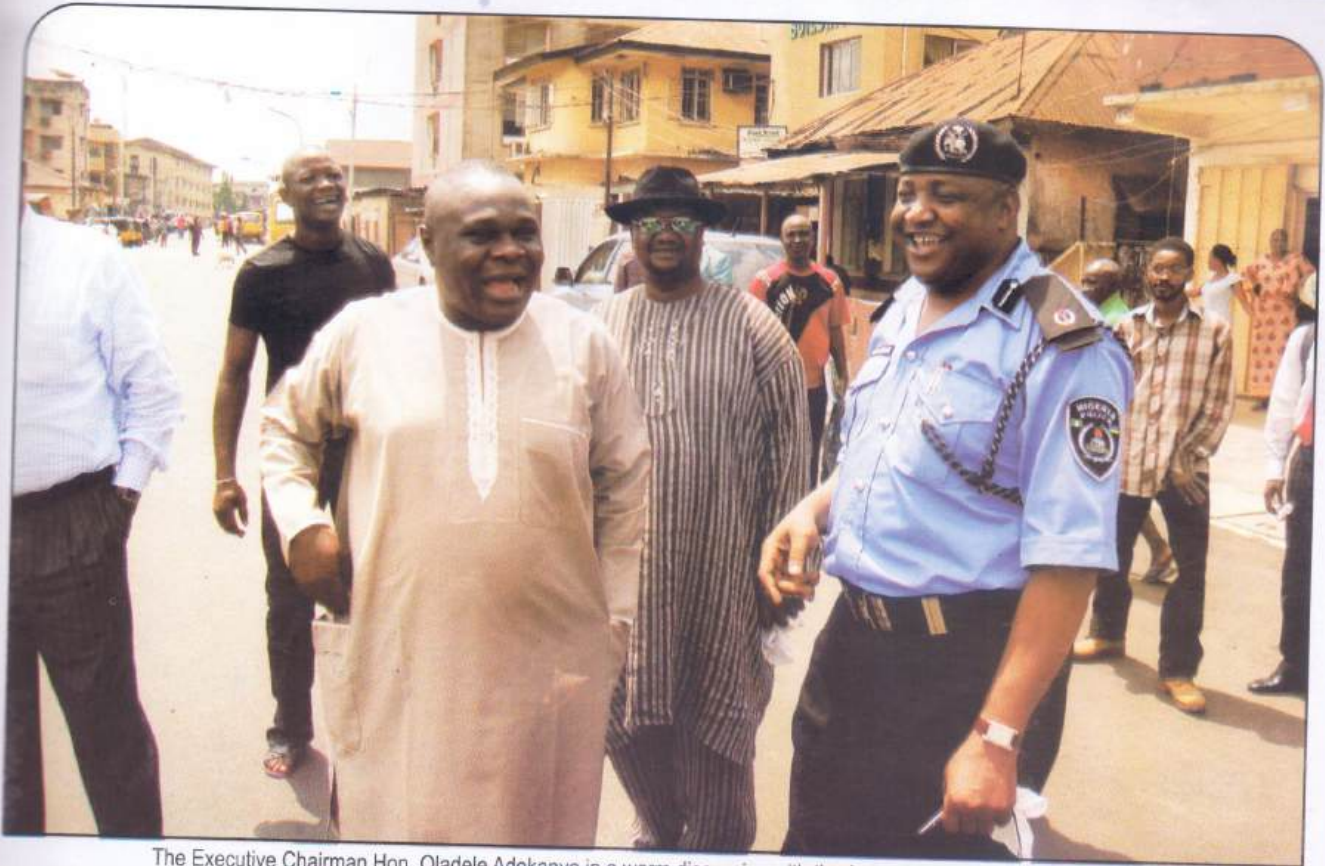

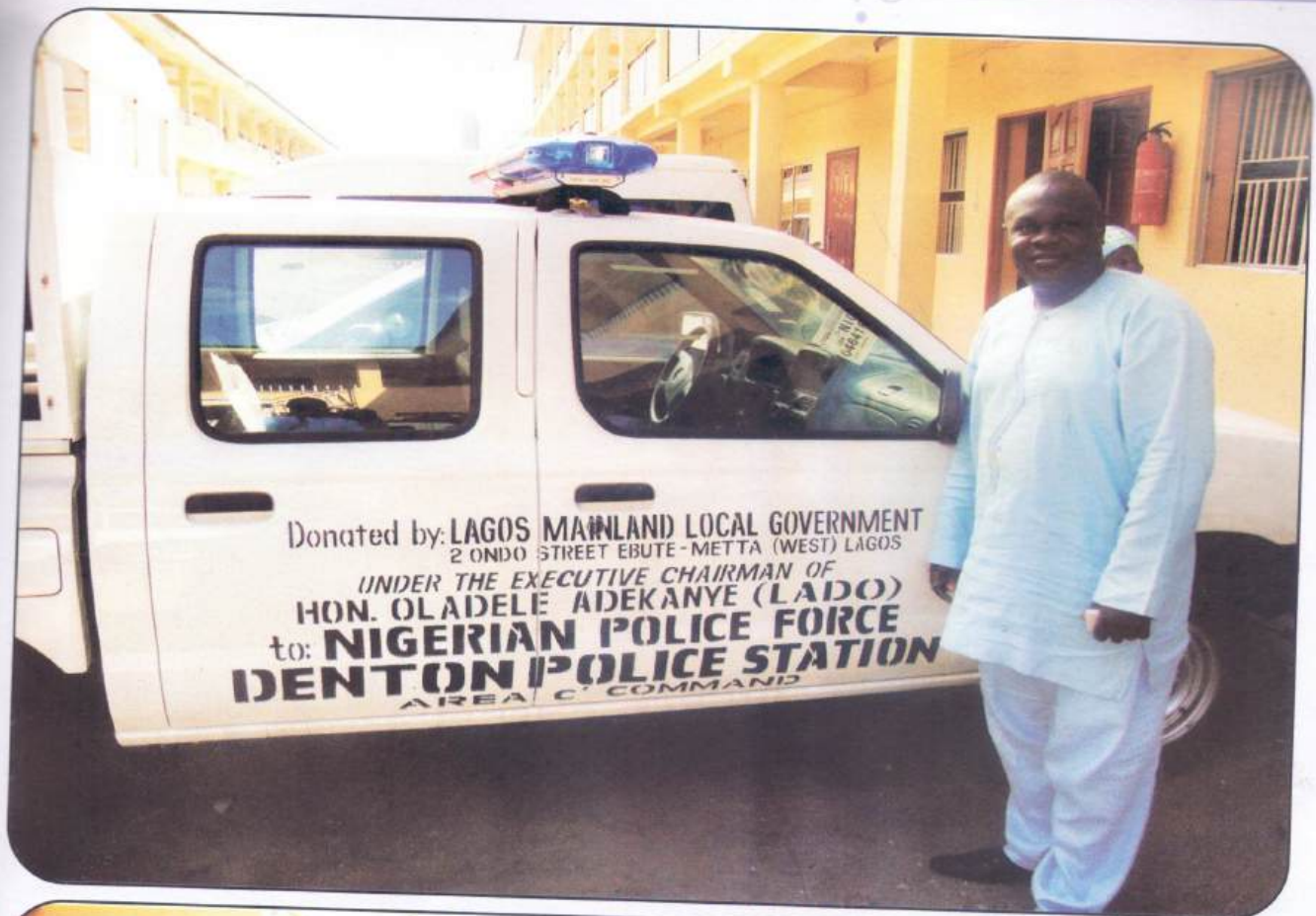

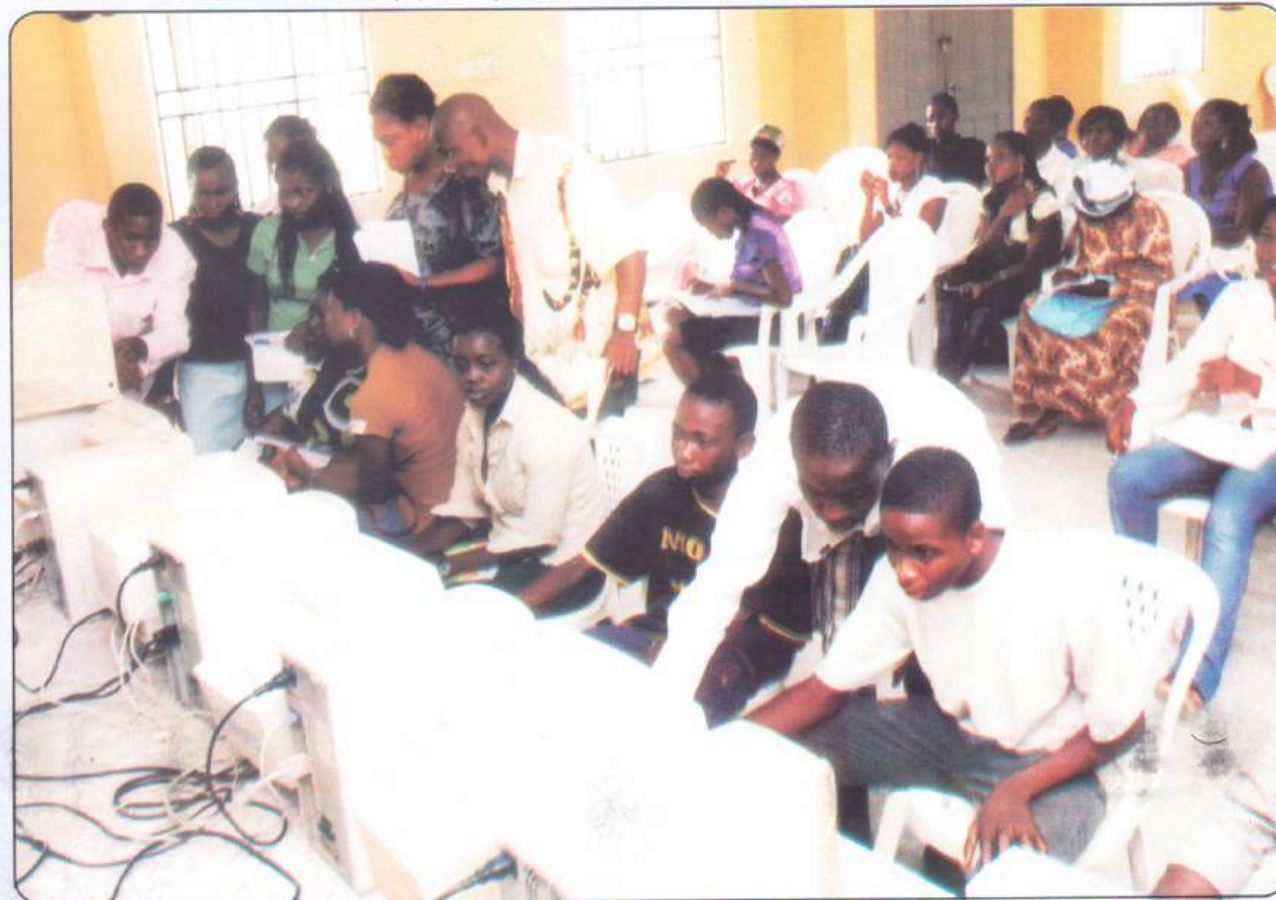
